There are special phone cards, which can save you a good amount of money but not as much as an international SIM card. The network of the destination country might not accept the SIM card that you have with you on your phone.

It is keeping these things in mind that you should opt in for an international SIM card while traveling abroad. When you are traveling abroad, you are not connected directly to your local network and are on what is known as a roaming network.

The local network picks up your incoming calls from the overseas network and passes on the same to your phone, provided that the same has got a compatible SIM card. The mobile agency of the destination country charges a termination charge, which is added to your phone bill. These termination charges along with the international call rates tend to inflate your mobile bill.

All this can be avoided by using an international SIM card. If the destination country network does not support your local network, you are forced to invest in another SIM card. This can become a bother if you are planning to visit several countries, since it means purchasing a different SIM card for each country.

Not only do you have to pay for the SIM cards, you have to keep on notifying your contacts of your new number each and every time you change your SIM card which itself is a costly proposition. An international SIM card relieves you of all these hassles and reduces your mobile bills and your tension too.
